Dos and Don'ts for your NHS Application

ALL NHS applicants will be notified of their standing via a letter delivered to their 2nd semester 1st period teacher.

DO

Get teacher recs done EARLY

Check on your application process in rm 152 during the last two weeks of January (1/22-2/9)

Check your GPA before you start the Application process (Counselor)

Check with Mrs. Bauer or Mrs. Steppling if you are unsure about your outside "service activity"

Use an email address that you check **DAILY**

Don'ts

Wait until the last minute for teacher recs Assume that we have everything Wait until the last minute for signatures.



Examples of outside "Service Activities"

NHS Members...Examples

Going with your church or synagogue to soup kitchens, environmental clean up... anything that would earn SSL hours...

From the application Examples of out of school activities are service activities or volunteer activities (SSL eligible) that benefit the school community, the neighborhood community, or a larger community. These can be a single event, like a "walk for the homeless" or working for Habitat for Humanity.

"Service Activities" that do not work

- Coaching a swim team, when you are on the team (no pre-team)
- CCD Class
- Bar Mitzvah classes
- Learning or teaching religion
- Helping with a play that you are performing in

From the application... Activities that only benefit the student are **NOT** acceptable. (Some examples of **UNACCEPTABLE** activities are jobs or internships, STARS, Humanities & Arts, private o group lessons/coaching or club organizations – such as Youth Orchestra, religion classes, sports clubs – these are **not service** activities)
